



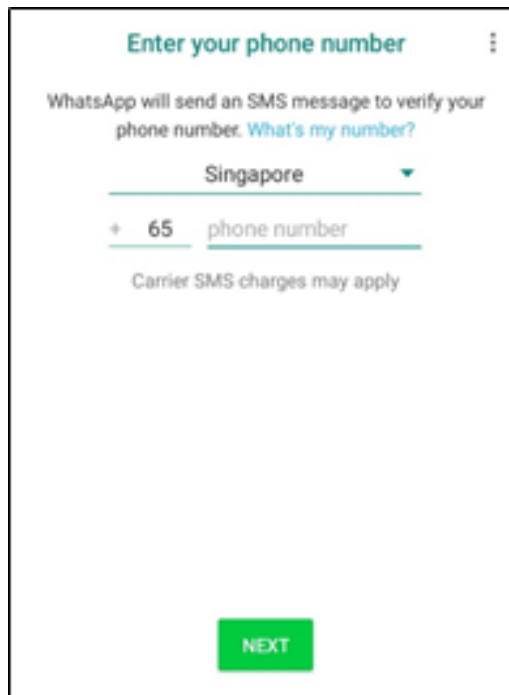
A guide on how to install WhatsApp application on your smartphone/tablet




<p>1.</p>	<p>Search for “WhatsApp” in Google Play Store (Android phone) or App Store (iPhone).</p>	
<p>2.</p>	<p>Click “Install”. Once the app has been downloaded, click on “Open”.</p>

4. Select ‘Singapore’ as the country and enter your phone number. Click next.
